

PUBLIC SKATING RULES

- 1.** The instructions set out in the Visitor Rules of the ice stadium also apply to public skating. Entry to public skating is permitted only with a valid ticket and at one's own risk.
- 2.** Children and minors may purchase a ticket only when accompanied by an adult over eighteen years of age, who must remain present throughout the skating session as the child's guardian and is responsible for the child.
- 3.** The duration of public skating is set in advance. After the announced end of the session, skaters must leave the ice surface immediately.
- 4.** Entry to the ice stadium premises for public skating is allowed 15 minutes before the start. Entry onto the ice surface is strictly prohibited while the ice is being resurfaced by the Zamboni.
- 5.** When skating on the ice surface, everyone must skate properly, at an appropriate speed and only in the designated direction so that other persons are not endangered. It is strictly prohibited to skate onto the figure-skating circles or the boards.
- 6.** All persons are required to wear gloves and long trousers while skating.
- 7.** Children under 10 years of age must wear a helmet while skating.
- 8.** Unless the operator decides otherwise, it is prohibited to bring a hockey stick, puck or other items onto the ice surface that could cause injury to others.
- 9.** All games are strictly prohibited during public skating (including sliding or throwing other objects).
- 10.** Entry onto the ice surface is permitted only through designated entrances, not by climbing over the boards.
- 11.** Public skaters may change into skates on the benches by the ice surface (or, in the event of high attendance, in the locker room; see the Locker Room Rules, the PIN code will be activated).
- 12.** The operator bears no responsibility for unattended belongings (see the Visitor Rules).
- 13.** Walking in skates outside the ice surface is permitted only where protective rubber mats are placed. Special care must be taken when walking in skates on stairs. Non-skating companions may use the stairway stand.
- 14.** Entry onto the ice surface without skates is prohibited, except when providing first aid in the event of an injury.
- 15.** Eating and drinking on the ice surface are prohibited. Food and beverages must not be placed on the boards.
- 16.** It is prohibited to enter areas that are not designated for visitors.
